TERMS AND RULES OF ENTRY

- 1. The awards are open to participants across the world working in any sector.
- 2. Jury members can participate but cannot score their own entries.
- 3. There are provided entry forms, which must be followed in order to present the most of your achievements and still allowing you to be as creative as you wish.
- 4. All entry forms must be completed in ENGLISH.
- 5. Entries must not exceed the required word count of each section. Longer entries will be automatically eliminated.
- 6. Entries must be presented in one file (doc, pdf, ppt). Videos, photos, and URL links must be included in the file.
- 7. Entries must be received prior to the submission deadline. Entries received after the submission deadline will not be accepted, if there is no official request for delays.
- 8. There is no restriction on the number of entries or categories for which entries may be submitted. Each entry needs to be on a separate form. A fee will be charged for each entry.
- 9. One project can be submitted to an unlimited number of categories. Each new category for the same project requires an additional standard fee.
- 10. Unlimited number of projects can be submitted to one category. Each new project for the same category requires an additional standard fee.
- 11. Entries that do not comply with the Barcelona Principles receive zero scores for results and impact.
- 12. Award winners and finalists will be announced during the awarding ceremony.
- 13. By entering the Awards, all entrants have agreed to allow the details of their entry to be shared with the judges and representatives of WCFA.
- 14. By entering the Awards, all entrants have agreed to allow the Short Presentation of their entries to be shared publicly.
